Dear Bob;

I have re-read the manuscript, and continue to like it. Again, I found some small problems, which are listed below:

- 1) Page 2, bottom two paragraphs: I do not like "robust models" twice in two successive sentences.
- 2) Page 3, first paragraph: "Scientific laws" appears four (!) times in four successive sentences.
- 3) Page 4: Need to be consistent...."Law of Mass Action" is capitalized here, but not elsewhere....
- 4) Page 9, line 4: should read: "...variational principles, and these have been developed by Chun Li...."
- 5) Page 9, paragraph 4: Should be H<sub>2</sub>O, not H<sub>2</sub>O....
- 6) Page 13, line 11: Should be "heart", not "hart"
- 7) Page 13, bottom line: Should read: "...recorded routinely in many laboratories because the electric field is so strong. If it were not so..."
- 8) Page 16, line 3: Should be K.S. Cole! Nickname was "Kacy", but initials were K.S.
- 9) Page 17, paragraph 3: One sentence paragraph should be part of preceding paragraph. I don't like one sentence paragraphs!
- 10) Page 19, paragraph 4: Might read "...or linear combinations of ....., or even fractional derivatives !"
- 11) Page 19, paragraph 5: Leave out reference to Hugh Huxley! Completely irrelevant! "....many years later working in Cambridge, UK."
- 12) Page 21, paragraph 2: Make part of paragraph one. No one sentence paragraphs!
- 13) Page 24, line 5: Leave out "in my opinion". Of course it is your opinion! Also, "Only then" occurs twice right next to each other...
